Health insurance

EU citizens

Health care assistance is available to all European citizens (belonging to EU Member States and EEA States) who have the EHIC/TEAM card (European Health Insurance Card) or who enroll in the Italian National Health Service.

If you have the EHIC/TEAM card, you can go directly to any family doctor, during the outpatient time, and have the right to any services needed, on a case by case basis. For a list of doctors and outpatient schedules, please visit the page Ricerca medici ("Search for doctors"). Students must bring their health card and a photocopy of the card to the clinic by doing so, the doctor will not request a payment for the visit.

Those who want to sign up into the Italian National Health service will have to ask the health insurance scheme of their country to issue the certificate E106 or E109 or S1 and present it at the counter of the Health District on Via Garibaldi 198.

If you have the requested forms and the tax code (issued at the *Agenzia delle Entrate* at Galleria Gerace Giovan Battista, 7/15, 56124 Pisa), the registration is free and you have the right to choose your own family doctor and take advantage of basic services.

EU member States: Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxemburg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Czech Republic, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Hungary.

EEA States (non UE members): Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Switzerland,

If you plan on staying in Italy for more than 3 months, you can register with the Italian local health care system. In this case, you must ask your National Health Institute for the European S1 Form and hand it in at Via Cocchi, 7, 56121 Pisa. You will be registered free of charge and will be able to choose and have your own doctor in Pisa.

Non EU/E.E.A. students – including UK

Medical hospital insurance is necessary in order to obtain a Visa and/or Residence Permit. In case you arrive to Italy without an insurance coverage you can make a voluntary inscription to Local Health Offices (Azienda Sanitaria Locale). If you have no insurance coverage upon your arrival to Pisa, you can request assistance at the Local Health Offices (Via Cocchi, 7, 56121 Pisa)

Guardia Medica

On public holiday and at night basic medical assistance is guaranteed by the **Guardia Medica**.

The Guardia Medica service guarantees basic medical assistance at home in situations designated as emergencies, and that take place at night or on public holidays.

More specifically: 8pm-8am from Monday to Friday and between 10am Saturday and 8am Monday, or on any day following a public holiday.

Bank account – Italian tax code

In order to open a bank account, to get a job, to sign a contract, to register with the Italian Health System and for receive medical assistance, you need to apply for an Italian tax code (codice fiscale) and ID card (Carta di Identità) After applying, you will receive a magnetic card with letters and numbers and the ID Card, which is used by banks, the health system, etc. to identify citizens.
